BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE

If you are currently incarcerated in a Florida prison and will be returning to Broward County upon release - request an application/referral for the Broward Reentry Center from a D.O.C. classification counselor or discharge planner.

If you were previously incarcerated in a Florida D.O.C. institution and are currently on probation - request a referral from your D.O.C. probation officer.

If you have already been released from a Florida D.O.C. institution - simply call **BREC** at **954.831.5316** to request an appointment. You may also come to **BREC** without an appointment; however, clients will be assisted on a first come first served basis.
