LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND WORKSHOP CAN WE HELP YOUR NON-PROFIT?

Every year, the Broward Sheriff's Office helps local non-profit organizations further their mission in the community by helping them apply for money from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF). Why not find out if this year we can help yours?

LETF money comes from the seizure and forfeiture of contraband that has been used in the commission of a felony, and state law allows BSO to use those funds for the benefit of the community.

Find out if your charitable organization is eligible to receive part of those funds at our upcoming workshop. This workshop is mandatory to become a recipient of LETF funds. Please, arrive early as doors will close promptly at 2 p.m.
