SUPPLY CHECKLIST:

Stock enough to last for at least 5 days.

- One gallon of water per person
- Canned food / Non-perishable
- Manual can opener
- Baby supplies
- Batteries
- Portable phone charger
- Flashlights and a radio
- Sanitation supplies
- Prescription medications
- First aid kit
- Fire extinguisher
- Full tank of gas
- Cash
- Essential items for your pets
