Install smoke alarms inside every bedroom, outside all sleeping areas and on every floor of your home.



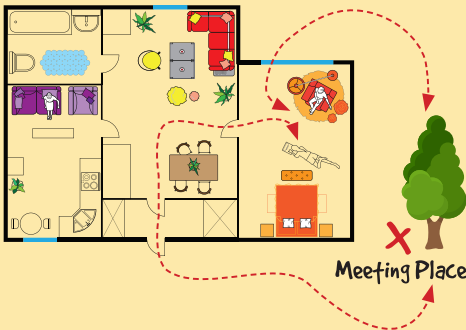
Place fire extinguishers on each floor of your home, especially in the kitchen and garage.
