You should ALWAYS include pets in your hurricane plan.

MAKE A PET HURRICANE PLAN

With a plan in place for your pets, you will know how to ensure their care during an emergency.

Things to include:

- **Evacuation information:** For a list of pet friendly shelters in Broward County, visit <https://www.broward.org/Documents/petbrochure.pdf>.
- **Comprehensive system of care:** Ensure someone you trust can care for or evacuate your pet if you cannot.
- **Vaccination records:** Pet-friendly hurricane shelters and most boarding kennels will not allow your pet admittance if they are not properly vaccinated and registered with the county.

**DO NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES,
LEAVE YOUR PET BEHIND.**

STAY INFORMED

BUILD A KIT

- Make a supply kit for your pet, keeping in mind their basic and most vital needs.
- Review your kit regularly to ensure the contents are fresh.

PET SUPPLY CHECKLIST

FOOD AND WATER

Keep several days supply of both.

MEDICINE

A supply of the medicine your pet takes on a regular basis.

FIRST AID KIT

TRAVELING BAG, CRATE OR CARRIER

For each pet.

BACKUP COLLAR WITH ID TAG

A PHOTO OF YOU WITH YOUR PETS

To help identify your pets if separated.

GROOMING ITEMS

In case your pet needs cleaning.

SANITATION NEEDS

Litter box, trash bags and other needed items.
