# KNOW THE LAW

## LOOK - ACKNOWLEDGE - WAIT

### L - LOOK

Always look both ways and make eye contact with drivers before crossing—don't rely solely on signals or bike lanes to stay safe.

### A - ACKNOWLEDGE

Don't assume drivers see you—wait for a clear sign like a nod or wave before crossing, and stay put if you're unsure.

### W - WAIT

Wait for the vehicle to come to a complete stop before entering the crosswalk or crossing the street. Rolling stops or distracted driving can turn a close call into a tragedy.

Whether you're jogging, walking or biking on a sidewalk, BSO reminds pedestrians and cyclists to follow the LAW – not just the legal rules, but the simple reminder to

**LOOK - ACKNOWLEDGE - WAIT.**
